"The idea behind the CNIT Forest concept came directly from CNIT itself. Its flared, taut shape, this curve, with its plant-like, tree-like allure, was a natural inspiration for ur light trees. It was also important for us to incorporate all the engineering prowess demonstrated by the architects: these trees have the potential to be vibrant and dynamic, animated by thousands of LEDs, so they can create a range of different climates for the events that the venue will host. Following in the footsteps of the audacious designers of the CNIT, we wanted to take visitors on a journey into an enchanting space, an unexpected underground forest."




#### CONTROLLING CONSUMPTION AND REDUCING WASTE

- Venue fully fitted out with **LED** energy saving
- **Eradication of single use plastics** with listed caterers
- Service for **empty packaging management** on site to save exhibitors and contractors the trouble of taking away their empty packaging, and returning it to them for breakdown
- Installation of water fountains without cups (made in France)

#### **GUARANTEEING SAFE AND SMOOTH OPERATIONS**

**Logipass** allows for controlling the flow of vehicles needing access to delivery docks, exhibitor car parks during set-up and breakdown, and for deliveries during event opening hours,

**Logistics pooling** reduces carbon emissions related to freight by minimizing the number of vehicles entering the site.
